These simple, inexpensive tips can help keep your home more comfortable and may reduce the amount of electricity you use:

- Postpone activities that require hot water—such as washing dishes or clothes to early morning or late evening. This will keep from adding more heat and humidity to the home.
- Raise the temperature setting on the thermostat. For every degree raised, customers can save as much as 3 percent on cooling costs.
- Turn off unnecessary incandescent lights during hot weather. They add to the heat in the home. Consider switching to cooler, energy-efficient fluorescent bulbs where light is needed.
- Use ceiling fans and portable floor fans to move the air around in the home. If the home does not have air conditioning, fans are essential for cooling. In homes with air conditioning, fans allow residents to raise the thermostat and save energy without affecting comfort.
- Close drapes during the hottest times of the day to block heat from entering the home and save energy.
- Make sure window air conditioners are sized correctly. Ones that are too small will run constantly but not cool the room. Ones that are too large use more energy than necessary.

Travel Smart

1. **Take transit** –The average U.S. household spends 18 cents of every dollar on vehicle-related transportation, the largest source of household spending after home mortgages. Visit the [511 Transit](#) page to find schedules and route maps, and to plan your trip using the [Transit Trip Planner](#). You can also call 511 to be directly transferred to any Bay Area transit agency for free. Just say "Transit Agencies" at the Main Menu and then the agency you'd like.
2. **Carpool** – Visit the [511 Rideshare](#) page to sign up for a carpool. All you need is one or two other people to make it work. Check out the [511 RideMatch Service](#) to instantly find neighbors and people who work nearby with whom you can commute. You can also call 511 to be directly connected to 511 Rideshare. Just say "Ridesharing" at the Main Menu.
3. **Walk or ride a bike** – It's good for your health and a climate-friendly way to commute. Visit the [511 Bicycling](#) page to use the [511 BikeMapperSM](#) and to find locations of lockers and racks, information on how to take your bike on public transit and across Bay Area toll bridges, tips on commuting, and more. You can also call 511 to be directly connected to the 511 Bike Operator. Just say "Bicycling" at the Main Menu.
4. **Telecommute** – Save time and money. Ask your employer if you can telecommute one day a week to start. If you're a part-time telecommuter, can you increase the number of telecommute days?
5. **Skip a trip** – Leave the car at home.
6. **Trip-link** – Consolidate trips and cut down on driving time, gas, greenhouse gases and air pollution. Every gallon of gas you save by driving less reduces 20 pounds of carbon dioxide.
7. **Keep luggage inside** your vehicle, not on the roof. Roof racks cut fuel economy by over 20%. Removing the roof rack further improves gas mileage.

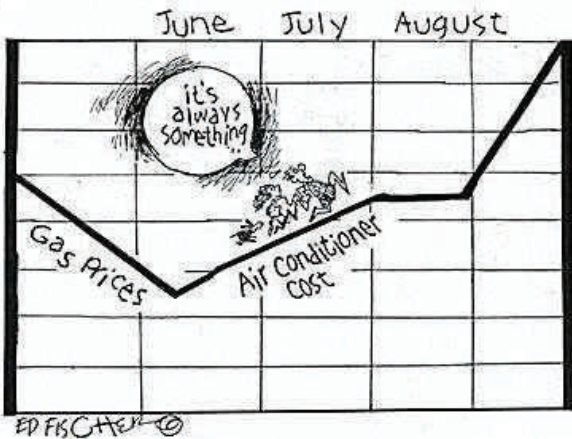

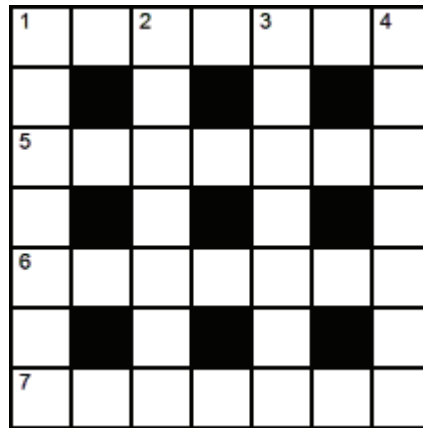

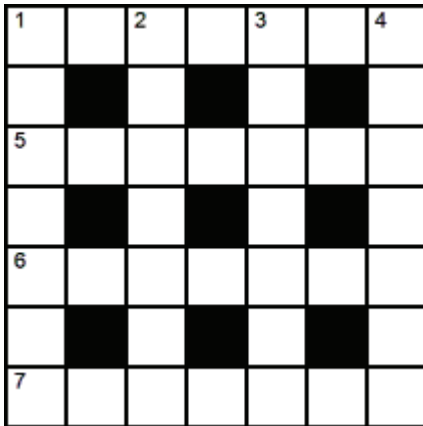
